ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to any Class 1 municipality; to prohibit more than one adult or unrelated juvenile criminal sex offender from residing in a residence; to provide for the owner or lessee who permits a violation to be fined; to provide exceptions; and in connection therewith would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. This act shall only apply in a Class 1 municipality.

Section 2. No adult or unrelated juvenile criminal sex offender shall establish a residence or other living accommodation in a residence where another criminal sex offender resides whose name appears on a published sex offender list the Jefferson County Sheriff's official published sex offender list.

(b) The owner or lessee of the property who knowingly willingly or intentionally permits a violation of subsection (a) shall be fined five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for each violation and those fees once collected will be

- (c) The owner or lessee of the property shall not be in violation of subsection (a) if the sex offender is the spouse or child of the owner or lessee or if the spouse or child is the owner or lessee of the property.
- (d) The owner is not in violation where the application for a lease or the lease itself provides a signed statement by the lessee that the lessee is not a convicted sex offender.

Section 3. Although this bill would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime.

Section 4. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
